Blackrock College and Willow Park Schools acknowledge the findings in the report issued to the Minister for Education by the Chair of the Scoping Inquiry, Mary O'Toole SC. We are deeply saddened and regretful that a significant number of students, in the care of the schools, were subjected to historical sexual abuse over many years. Both the scale of the abuse and the duration of the timeframe over which the abuse was perpetrated is shocking and a shameful period in the history of the schools.

Blackrock College and Willow Park Schools reaffirm their commitment to supporting the survivors and we would encourage anyone who has not yet chosen to come forward, to consider doing so.
